

ELITE POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC 2020

MISS POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC is a prestigious title of the year in the national battle competition of elite pole dancers who have been at the top level of pole dance for several years. The dancers participate in the development and promotion of the pole dance sport in the Czech Republic and are considered highly respected celebrities. These elite pole dancers were written into the history of pole dance in the Czech Republic with their active involvement.

Eight of the contestants are carefully selected by an expert committee from the nominees of the Czech pole dance. The contestants will compare their strength, experience, skills and talent in a three-stage battle pyramid during a unique gala evening.

The expert committee is composed of trained judges, led by the Main Judge and accompanied by a lay jury, They will ensure that the unique title MISS POLE DANCE CZR is really carried with pride and thus inspires other athletes and pole dancers in developing their acrobatic-gymnastic skills, creativity and strengthening the love of dance in their hearts.

There is only one winner of the battle competition. The elite eight will compete for the title of MISS POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC for 2020 and the best dancer will be qualified for the final round of the Czech Championship in Pole Dance ČSPD in the same year, so the winner has the opportunity to defend their first place.

I. ORGANIZER ELITE POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC 2020

The organizer of the competition is ČESKÝ SVAZ POLE DANCE, z.s., with the official abbreviation ČSPD, ID 085 42 279. ČSPD is an organization of independent sports associations and athletes, whose subject of activity is the pursuit of pole dance sport and related sports activities. The aim of the ČSPD is to organize, develop and promote pole dance sport, increase its social prestige, foster universal development, and support the interests of its members in connection with their activities within the ČSPD.

II. THE PLACE AND TIME OF THE COMPETITION

Competition date: March 21, 2020 (Saturday)



III. COMPETITORS

Competitor is a person older than 18 years, which can take part in the ELITE POLE DANCE CZR 2020 contest. Competitors younger than 18 years have to arrange a confirmation of competition participation with signature of their legal representative. Every young competitor has a responsible adult who guarantees on the event spot for the younger competitor. The confirmation of the responsible adult on the event spot is accompanied by the consent of the legal representative of the younger competitor. Competitors are selected by a professional committee of the ČSPD, its decision is based on success at national and international competitions nominated, according to competences and merits in the pole dance community, according to activities that support the development and promotion of pole dance in the Czech Republic.

IV. ELITE POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC COMPETITION RULES

The Elite Pole Dance Czech Republic competition is composed of battles into a pyramid system, where in the first round all eight pole dancers compete divided into pairs. The competition begins with four battles and each battle has its winner. These four winners of the first round compete divided into two battles in semifinal round. Two winners of semifinal round create final round, in which compete for the prestigious title MISS POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC.

The first round of battles (8 competitors) – static mode of pole

The second round (semifinal – 4 competitors) – spinning mode of pole

The third round (final – 2 competitors) – mode is given by lottery of referee



IV.a NOMINATIONS AND APPLICATIONS

Competitors are nominated by the expert committee of the ČSPD, these selected nominees are contacted by the organizer of ELITE POLE DANCE CZR 2020. The elite eight competitors is asked to fill in the application form and they will receive information about the competition day.

IV.b THE LAST PREPARATIONS BEFORE FINAL EVENING

STARTING LIST

The start list is composed of the competitors names and will be published in time before competition for obtain a important space for dancers promotion.

ADVERTISING, SPONSORS, CONTESTANT PARTNERS

The competitor represents himself, the coach and the sports facilities. The time reserved for the competitor on stage can be used to promote his sponsors and partners during his performance, in case it doesn't disrupt his performance. The finalist will communicate with the organizing team about the way of the required promotion. It's possible to use the video projection. Contestants send the materials until 29.2.2020.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Every competitor is obliged to send/deliver his medical certificate for competing until 29.2.2020. The medical certificate cannot be older than one year. The competitor thus confirms his medical certificate of competition event. The organizer provides medical supervision during the competition day.

ENTOURAGE

Every competitor reports the name of one person, by which is competitor accompanied in the backstage on the competition day.

STARTING FEE

The elite eight competitors nominated by the ČSPD do not pay any entry fee and after receiving the entry form by the organizer, the competitor becomes a member of ČESKÝ SVAZ POLE DANCE, z.s. for free for one calendar year.

MUSIC

Every contestant gives the organizer 1-3 songs during which he would like to come into the stage.

IV.c PRESS CONFERENCE and STAGE REHEARSAL

The press conference takes place on the competition day with the registration of competitors. During press conference is the official draw of the elite eight. The elite eight is divided by drawing into individual battles by competitors. There is also place for talking, photos, interviews, questions about organization of the competition and then a stage rehearsal for the performers. The rehearsal is used to clarify the entry to stage and to test the poles.

IV.d FINAL EVENING

The final evening takes place at the Grand Hotel Bohemia Prague in March, 21, 2020. The final evening is public and in front of the audience and the jury, which is composed of at least three members.

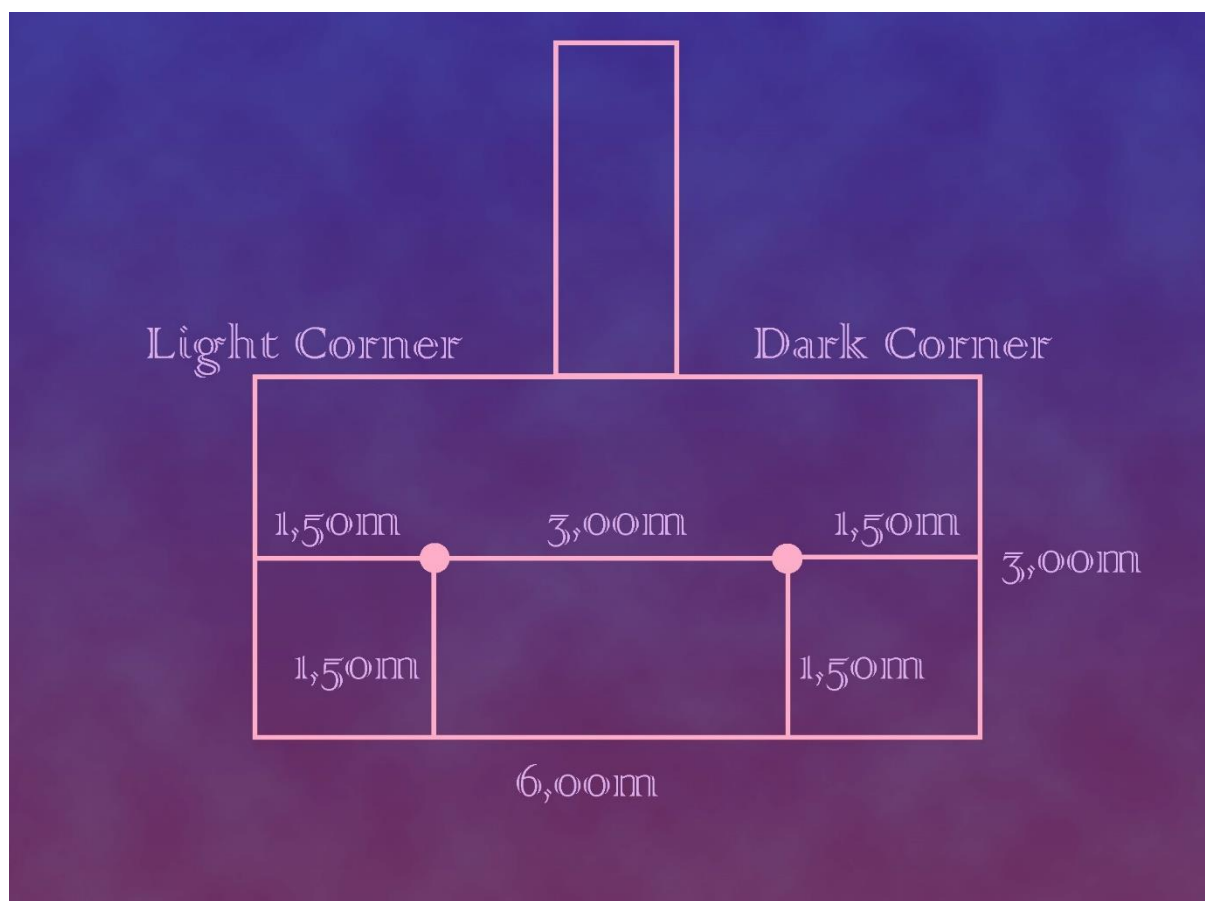
BATTLE MUSIC

The contestants don't know the battle music in before their performances because of testing improvisation abilities. The only known criterion of music is the fulfillment of the 4 minutes condition. Four minutes allow to make fairly performance for both contestants. This condition make possible the contestants to show their best.

LENGTH OF PERFORMANCES

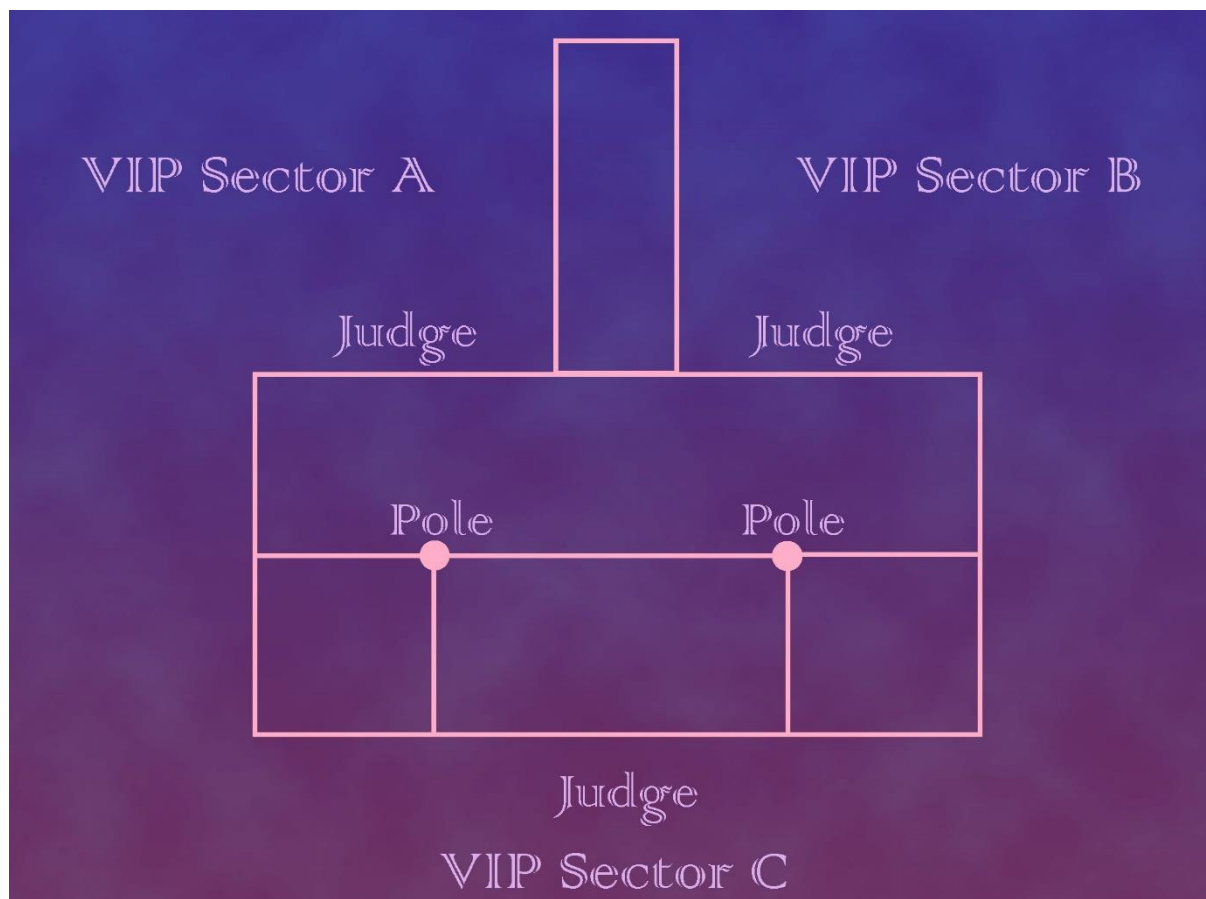
Contestants perform at minute intervals, twice per one battle. The timekeeping will be announced to competitors by a clear sound signal.

0:00 – 1:00	1st contestant – the light corner
1:00 – 2:00	2nd contestant – the dark corner
2:00 – 3:00	1st contestant – the light corner
3:00 – 4:00	2nd contestant – the dark corner



POLE DANCE POLES AND STAGE

The stage will have 2 poles with a length of 4 meters and a diameter of 45 mm.
The stage will be seated in a space surrounded by spectators.



RULES OF USING POLES AND STAGE

Both battle competitors have their own one pole.

The competitor is obliged to use the pole in 75 % of the total length.

The contestant must not touch the opposing pole, otherwise he will be disqualified.

It is not allowed to grip the pole, grip can be applied only on the body.

In case of unexpected technical problems, the organizer reserves the right to change the use of the pole mode from spin to static.

Contestants must not repeat the same combination of elements they have already used during the evening.

COSTUME

Each contestant will have a light and dark costume for the competition evening to distinguish the assigned light and dark corners.

Gloves, sleeves, pads and heel shoes are not allowed.

Unintentional or intentional disclosure of intimate games means disqualifying the competitor.

V. THE JURY AND THE SYSTEM OF EVALUATION, RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF COMPETITORS AND JURISERS

V.a COMPOSITION OF JUDGES and THE EVALUATION SYSTEM

The competition is evaluated by an expert committee trained by the ČSPD, consisting of at least three members. The panel includes one main judge, who oversees the accuracy of the panel evaluation. The expert committee evaluates the performance of the athlete, the dancer, his performance, the interaction with the spectators, the difficulty and originality of the dance elements and the variety of improvisation. Penalties for non-stretched knees and toes, unintentional fall, loss of balance and wiping hands are included. The score is only for informational purposes. The Score Sheet is available for review. Each referee will give the name of the winner of the each battle. In case of a tie will be all points added from all referees to determine the advancer to the next round.

V.b THE PROTEST AGAINST THE COMMISSION'S ASSESSMENT

In case of a reasonable disagreement with the evaluation of the competition, the athlete, the dancer has the possibility to submit a written protest within 30 minutes together with the fee for raising the protest to the main organizer of the competition. The protest letter must contain the name and surname of the protestor, the reason for the protest, a precise description of the situation and the protestor's signature. The organizer will comment on the protest within 24 hours, either on the spot or electronically to the competitor's e-mail.

VI. DISQUALIFICATION AND EXCLUSION

The competitor will be eliminated from the competition if the necessary documents are not delivered within the set deadlines.

The competitor will be excluded from the competition in case of non-compliance with the competition rules and conditions for participation.

The contestant will be excluded from the contest when providing false information to the organizer, either in the contest application form or in the full extent of cooperation with the contest organizer.

A competitor may be disqualified on the basis of unsportsmanlike or unethical behavior.

A contestant may be disqualified if he intentionally endangers the health and safety of the contestants.

A competitor will be disqualified if he fails to arrive in time at the designated place on the day of the final.

A contestant will be disqualified if he / she leaves the stage prematurely during the performance.

A competitor will be disqualified if he or she deliberately interferes with the judges' assessment before or during the competition.

The contestant must not touch the opposing pole, otherwise he will be disqualified.

The decision on disqualification during the competition is announced by the main judge from the expert committee.

VII. THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANIZER

The organizer will provide medical supervision during the final evening.

On the day of the finals, the organizer will provide a stage test for the competitors at the set time.

The organizer will ensure the training of professional jurors under the auspices of the ČSPD. The organizer will check the fixation of the sports equipment before the final evening.

The organizer will ensure that the poles are cleaned before each battle during the final evening.

The organizer is not responsible for the loss of things, props and valuables during the competition.

VIII. PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEOS, PUBLICATION, GDPR

Each contestant submits his / her consent to the use of personal data for the purpose of organizing the contest, for its promotion, and also to the possession of videos and photographs for the purpose of the contest's operation, association and promotion of sport.

The organizer will provide an official photographer and cameraman for recording the performance of the competitors.

A private photographer or cameraman who does not have the official permission of the ČSPD moves in the reserved areas for spectators so as not to limit the view of the spectators, jurors and is obliged to present a valid ticket and follow the organizer's instructions.

Photos and videos taken from the event ELITE POLE DANCE CZECH REPUBLIC will be free downloadable and are allowed to use for private purposes.
